Abstract

Background:

Previous research has examined the association between parents' and children's posttraumatic stress disorder symptoms (PTSS) after a variety of traumatic events. However, longitudinal parent-child dyadic studies are scarce.

Methods:

Independent self-reports were collected from parent-adolescent dyads (n=688) after the 2008 Wenchuan earthquake. Adolescents (Mean = 15.22 years; 61.6% female) and one of their parents (Mean = 41.04 years; 58.1% female) each reported on their PTSS at 12 (T_{12m}) and 18 months (T_{18m}) following the earthquake.
