Highlights

- Limited research has explored perpetration of intimate partner cyberstalking
- Predicted perpetration of intimate partner cyberstalking from gender and personality
- Women more likely to perpetrate intimate partner cyberstalking than men
- All Dark Tetrad traits positively associated with intimate partner cyberstalking
- Results have implications for cyberstalking interventions
