Highlights

- Significant associations were found between functional impairment and antisocial, avoidant, borderline, obsessive-compulsive, and schizotypal personality disorders in both Section II and Section III..
- Smaller associations were found between impairment and narcissistic personality disorder in both Section II and Section III.
- The Section III trait-based measurement of personality psychopathology showed greater associations with functional impairment.
