### Highlights

- With biparental care, mate preferences cannot be disentangled from PI decisions.
- Females may use a males attractiveness to gauge his likelihood of providing care.
- Greater variation among males due to PI decisions leads to lesser female choosiness.
- When males adjust parental investment, females mate with low-quality males more often.
