

Highlights:

- Anti-bullying laws lead to decreases in-school bullying victimization (8.4%).
- Provisions with specific definition of the term bullying are even more effective.
- Potential delayed effect of the laws on bullying victimization.
- Stronger effects of laws on bullying for earlier grades.
- Smaller schools benefit much more from implementation of the legislation.
