

Highlights

- Fecal Microbiota Transplantation (FMT) is becoming an important treatment option in many chronic gastrointestinal diseases.
- Little is known about the effectiveness of FMT on psychiatric symptoms.
- FMT showed significant improvement of depression, anxiety and sleep subscale scores in patients with Functional Gastrointestinal Disease (FGID).
- Significant negative correlation between baseline microbiota diversity and depression severity were observed.

• The increase of microbiota diversity after FMT was correlated with improvement in depression scores.
