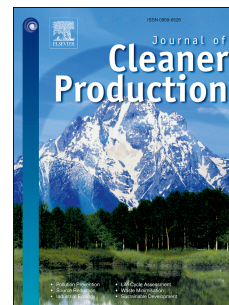


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Effect of meteorological conditions on onsite runoff control for reducing the hydrological footprint of green building
