Highlights

- We test the impact of prior impulse control and glucose on monetary discounting.
- Prior impulse control increases patience, in contrast with the resource model.
- A placebo is just as effective as glucose in increasing patience.
- The interventions operate by reducing utility curvature and present bias.
- We suggest a two-systems mechanism to explain our results.
