The reinitiation of postpartum sexual activity is influenced by the numerous changes that occur in a woman's anatomy, her hormonal status, partner relationships and the family structure that accompany the birth (Leeman and Rogers, 2012). Some women report dyspareunia and difficulties associated to sexual desire, excitation, lubrication and orgasm which affect the quality of their sexual activity.(Rathfisch et al., 2010).
