Highlights

- A solution of 3 latent classes better explain the patterns of adolescent drug use.
- Exists a gradient of association between parenting styles and adolescent drug use.
- The adolescents of negligent parents were more likely to be in drug use classes.
- Activities to reduce parental negligent should be included in drug prevention.

Abstract

Background: To identify different patterns of drug use in adolescence and determine if these are associated with parenting styles and other sociodemographic factors.

Methods: A latent class analysis was conducted using baseline data collected in a sample (n=6,381) from a randomized controlled trial conducted to evaluate the effectiveness of the
