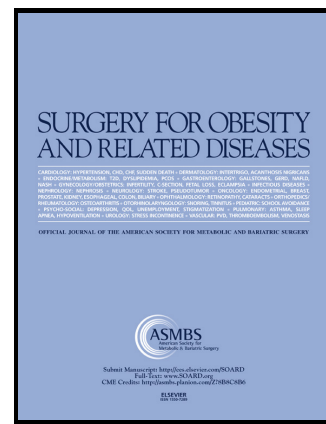

Abstract

Background: Literature on patient motivation for bariatric surgery remains limited.

A few studies have examined relation to outcomes and found no established connection between motivation and weight loss.

Setting: A retrospective convenience sample of 345 participants was recruited from an obesity support website to complete an online survey.

Methods: Content analysis was used to describe motivations for surgery, and analysis of variance and covariance were completed to compare groups of
