Highlights

- Whilst certain preconceptions about the realities of sustainable construction might well persist, the enshrining of practical routes to the adoption of sustainable practice within material specification and regulation are likely to have the greatest and most significant effect on sustainable work practices.
- The study results showed a widespread awareness within the industry of the importance of sustainable construction and its impact on the environment.
- The influence of Client awareness and perceived value of sustainable design and practice appeared to still represent a barrier to adoption.
