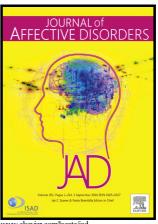

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## Abstract Background.

The relative importance of individual and country-level factors influencing access to diagnosis and treatment for depression across the world is fairly unknown.

#### Methods.

We analysed cross-national data from the WHO World Health Surveys. Depression diagnosis and access to health care were ascertained using a structured interview.

Logistic Bayesian Multilevel analyses were performed to establish individual and country

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
