## Highlights

• An original experiment is designed to expose student cheating at an <u>individual</u> level.

- Contrary to previous experiments, many students were found to cheat maximally.
  - Student cheating is positively correlated with three achievement measures.
  - Contrary to survey-based studies, higher achievers were found to be bigger cheaters.
